DEFENSE LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY TEST (DLPT) ILR Score in target language:

NOTE ON THE DLPT: The Interagency Language Roundtable (ILR) scale is a set of descriptions of abilities to communicate in a language. It is the standard grading scale for language proficiency in the Federal service. The lower-level exams, available at any base Language Resource Center (LRC), determines a Marine's language proficiency on a scale of 0-3. The designation of 0+, 1+, 2+, is assigned when proficiency substantially exceeds one skill level and does not fully meet the criteria for the next level. Grades are be assigned separately for different skills such as reading, speaking, listening. Tests can be taken in a one or two day period. Marines desiring a region change and claim a proficiency in a target language are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** to take the DLPT for their language at their local LRC prior to submission of the RCLF Region Change Request.
